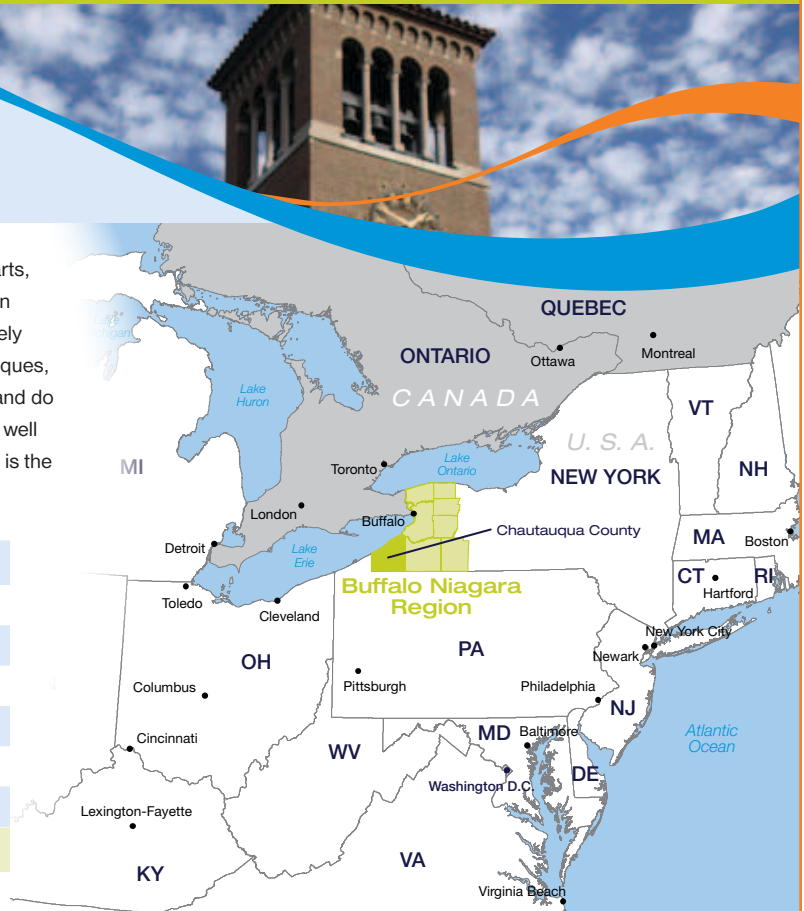

Antiques, campgrounds, fine dining and winter sports are just some of the things to see and do in the area. Peek 'n Peak Resorts is home to a PGA tournament every year, as well as a prime location for skiers and winter sports lovers everywhere. Jamestown is the county's largest city, located less than 40 miles from Erie, Pa.

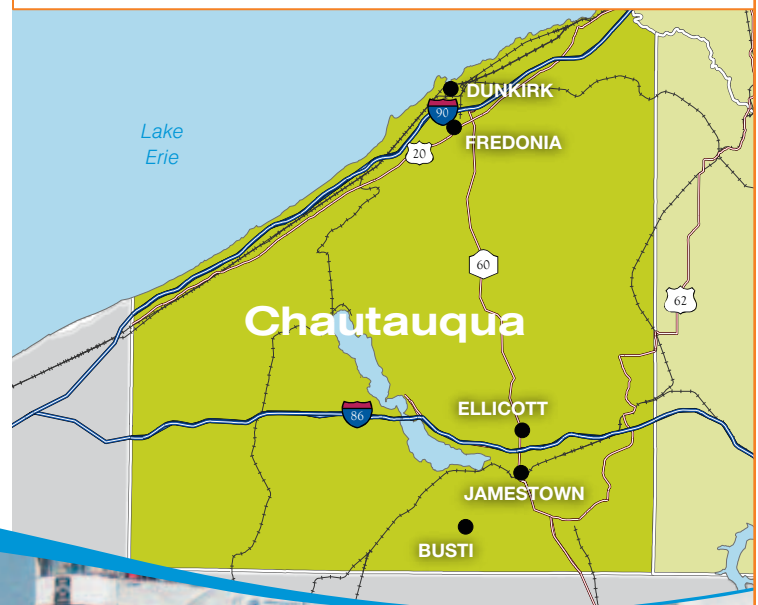
