Wyoming County attracts visitors from all over with its outdoor attractions, including Letchworth State Park, "The Grand Canyon of the East." It is also the homeland of the Seneca Nation of Indians, known as the "keepers of the Western Door" of the Iroquois Federation. Attractions include the Arcade & Attica Railroad, Silver Lake State Park, scores of museums and art galleries, and many area specialty shops. The historic Gaslight Village is still lit by original gas lamps and contains more than 70 homes listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The region also has an array of restaurants offering tasty cuisine, and a number of resorts, campground areas, and bed and breakfasts.
