Industrial Spec Space

2 Steelworkers Way is Uniland Development's next 150,000 sq.ft., single story industrial building featuring 36 ft. clear height and generous column spacing to serve as a hub for manufacturing, warehousing, logistics, and trucking operations. It can also support multimodal operations, single or multiple tenants, and customized office build-out. 8 Dona Street, the first industrial spec building on the site, was completed in 2022 and has been fully leased to Total Quality Assurance International and Max Advanced Brakes.

Join TMP Technologies, Sucro Sourcing & Welded Tube

In 2013, Welded Tube invested \$48 million on the construction of a new 109,000 sq. ft. facility on 45 acres.

TMP Technologies purchased a 28-acre parcel and constructed a 280,000 sq. ft. manufacturing facility in 2021.

Sucro Sourcing is investing \$19 million to transform three abandoned buildings over a 12-acre space. The project will be completed in phases by 2024.

Highway

Renaissance Commerce Park is just 5.5 miles from interstate 190, 6.5 miles from downtown Buffalo, 105 miles to Toronto, and 187 miles to Cleveland.



International Bridge

Renaissance Commerce Park is seven minutes from the Peace Bridge. (One of four US-Canada bridges)



Rail

Access to four Class I rail lines (CSX Transportation, Norfolk Southern, Canadian Pacific Railway, and Canadian National Railway)



Port

Adjacent to deep-water port access at the Port of Buffalo, the first major U.S. Port of Call encountered when entering the Great Lakes. Located on two hundred acres, the Port consists of 28 terminals, and features a 230-ton American crawler crane.



Air

Renaissance Commerce Park is 12 miles from the Buffalo-Niagara international Airport.
